The Elegance of Crystal Symphony Welcome to your home-away-from-home.

Crystal Symphony was commissioned in December 1992 and the contract was signed on March 2, 1993. Just over two years later, on April 18, 1995, the 50,202 ton Crystal Symphony sailed out of her birthplace, the Kværner Masa Yard in Turku, Finland. The design team for Crystal Symphony was headed by noted ship designer, Robert Tillberg, of Sweden.

What does a dream like Crystal Symphony cost? Over 250 million dollars in 1995. Plus, a couple of multi-million dollar refurbishments — the most recent in 2009 — to further enhance this already-elegant ship.

This mighty vessel upon which you are now sailing is 781 feet in length (238m) and 98.5 feet wide (30m). The draft is 24.9 feet (7.6m). She has a cruising speed of 22 knots, a maximum speed of 23 knots and is propelled by two electric motors powered by six diesel engines with an output of 53,000 horse-

power. With a capacity of 922 guests and a crew of 566, Crystal Symphony maintains Crystal Cruises' mark of excellence with one of the best guest to crew ratios in the cruise industry.

Crystal Deck 5

On Crystal Deck 5, the Crystal Cove and Crystal Plaza provide an open and elegant feeling. Crystal Symphony features a two-story atrium with a beautiful dome of stained glass, a waterfall and the comfortable and inviting Crystal Cove piano bar and lobby area.

The semi-spiral staircase descends to the Crystal Deck 5 Crystal Plaza area, including the lobby, Reception Desk, Concierge, Shore Excursions, Crystal Society Hostess and Cruise Sales Consultant Desks, as well as the entrance to the magnificent Crystal Dining Room which offers distinctive international cuisine and a world-renowned wine list. side is the expanded Medical Center, featuring the latest medical equipment and facilities.

Entertainment Tiffany Deck 6

The main entertainment deck on Crystal Symphony is Tiffany Deck 6. Renovated in fall 2006, the midship Starlite Club offers panoramic views of the ocean with its innovative, freeflowing design featuring a dance floor and bandstand. This elegant club also hosts occasional cabaret performances.

The Galaxy Lounge, all the way forward on Tiffany Deck 6, is a 463-seat showroom sloped around a spacious hydraulic stage to accommodate Crystal Cruises' spectacular, award-winning production shows, world-class guest entertainers, variety acts and big-band dancing.

The Library on Tiffany Deck 6 Midship offers over 3,000 books and a wide selection of movies on DVD, music CDs and audio books which can be checked out daily.

Computer University@Sea gives a variety of free classes and allows guests to stay in touch electronically with their homes and offices. Next door, Bridge players can enjoy the spacious and well-lit Bridge Lounge, with comfortable tables for duplicate and rubber games. Daily Bridge instruction is offered on days at sea, with no-host Bridge games played every afternoon.

The Avenue of the Stars shopping arcade has three specialty shops around the Tiffany Deck 6 atrium: Apropos features Crystal Cruises signature apparel, and accessories for both ladies and gentlemen and Facets offers fine jewelry and collectibles. The Crystal Collection shop displays the classic fragrances and cosmetics

of Chanel and handbags by MCM.

The Crystal Photo Shop displays the many pictures taken by our professional onboard photo team; it is on Tiffany Deck 6 Aft, Starboard side.

The popular Avenue Saloon, Connoisseur Club and The Bistro are also located on Tiffany Deck 6. Avenue Saloon is a comfortable meeting place before and after dinner, where night owls enjoy the piano bar entertainment in a warm ambience. The adjacent Connoisseur Club offers a fine selection of international cigars, cognac, vintage port wines and single malt whiskies. The Bistro serves international coffees and teas, daytime snacks and a selection of wines by the glass.

The Hollywood Theatre shows recent-release movies and features a special audio device system for the hearing impaired.

Crystal Casino has four blackjack tables, as well as roulette, craps, three-card poker and mini-Baccarat (available upon request). The casino also has 97 slot machines and one of the highlights is the chance to play Ultimate Texas Hold 'Em poker.

Adjacent to the casino is our latest innovation in nightclubs—LUXE. Featuring Philippe Starck furniture and ambient lighting that changes throughout the evening, LUXE is the place to gather before or after our shows, or while enjoying the gaming at our casino.

Our alternative restaurants, Silk Road and The Sushi Bar, and Prego are both located on the port side of Tiffany Deck 6 Aft. Silk Road and The Sushi Bar, added to Crystal Symphony in 2008, offer the unique and inspired cuisine of Master Chef Nobu Matsuhisa. In the fall of 2009, our Venetian-inspired specialty

restaurant, Prego, was completely renovated and now features a new entrance, walls made of luxurious padded fabric, chandeliers and mosaic floors. A spectacular mural that pays tribute to many famous Italian artists adorns the wall. This wonderful restaurant offers delicious Italian fare. Both Silk Road and Prego restaurants have separate entrances and breathtaking views of the ocean.

The Vintage Room is one of the most unique dining experiences offered at sea. Located between the Starlite Club and Silk Road on the port side of Tiffany Deck 6 Aft, this venue was created to promote wine education and the vast range of fine wine selections offered on board.

In addition to occasional daytime wine tastings and discussions, guests may partake in a variety of wine "themed" dinners on any evening of their choice during the cruise.

Promenade Deck 7

The full outside Promenade Deck 7 of Crystal Symphony has been designed for walking and jogging enthusiasts; 3.7 laps around the Promenade deck equals one mile.

Lido Deck 11

On Lido Deck 11, you will find our Seahorse Pool — an outdoor pool suitable for doing laps. Adjacent to the Seahorse Pool is an oversize Jacuzzi* with a special water feature, which was added during the ship's 2009 refurbishment.

The Lido Café is our casual dining area for breakfast and lunch and, on select evenings, we offer casual dining. The aft dining area of the Lido Café has a canopy, allowing guests the chance to enjoy some shade while dining outside. Under the retractable magrodome is the outdoor

Trident Bar and Grill, which serves hot dogs, hamburgers, pizza and sandwiches. There is also a full bar and an adjoining ice cream bar. The Trident Grill also offers a Late-Risers Breakfast.

With its panoramic view and comfortable ambiance, the Palm Court is the ideal place for quiet relaxation during the day, afternoon tea service, or intimate pre-dinner cocktails.

Lido Deck 11's youth activities center includes the Fantasia children's playroom plus Waves teen center and video arcade.

Sun Deck 12

The Crystal Spa & Salon on Deck 12 shows off sweeping ocean views while guests relax and indulge in the treatments offered. Following the design principles of Feng Shui, the ancient practice of balance and harmony, the facility features eight treatment rooms, a relaxation area, private canopied teak sundeck, as well as a state-of-the-art steam shower and sauna area. Other highlights include custom-designed manicure/pedicure areas with sunken foot bowls, ideal for the "Sole Delight Foot Ritual" with warmed aromatherapy oils and massage prior to a full pedicure. The luxurious dry float bed suite, appropriate for singles or couples, contains a sensory bed to create a feeling of weightlessness, ideal for "Aroma Spa" and other treatments.

The Fitness Center boasts a separate room for the line's complimentary exercise classes, including yoga, Pilates mat classes and circuit training. Personal training instruction is also offered. The gym features plenty of state-of-the-art fitness equipment featuring cardio theater TV, and guests can take advantage of the LifeFitness treadmills, cross trainers, spin bikes and recumbent

and upright life cycles (all with heart rate sensors) and the Kinesis strength-training machine to help stay in shape during the cruise. With 6,000 square feet of space, the spa and fitness facility offers guests the opportunity to treat themselves to a complete spa experience while at sea.

Sun Deck 12 is also home for the outdoor sports fan. The Wimbledon paddle tennis court, golf driving nets and putting green are located on this deck, and will provide hours of enjoyment.

The Staterooms

Crystal Symphony was the first luxury ship to feature private verandahs or large picture windows (not portholes) in all of its 480 outside staterooms on Decks 5, 7, 8, 9 and 10. More than 57% of the penthouses and staterooms feature large, private verandahs. The standard stateroom has been designed to offer additional space for our guests, including 15 drawers and nine feet of hanging space in the closet.

In the November 2006 refurbishment, all staterooms were redesigned and sport new bathrooms, updated color schemes, upholstery and furnishings. Decks 5 and 9 have been decorated in rich hues of burgundy, terracotta and tan. Deck 7 features tones of lavender, gold and taupe. Shades of aqua, pearl and gray adorn Deck 8. In addition, each stateroom now boasts a 20" LCD flatscreen television and beautiful Murano glass bedside lamps. In the bathrooms, beautiful oval vessel sinks have been added to the new granite countertops.

Penthouse Deck 10

Penthouse Deck 10 offers nineteen 491-square-foot Penthouse Suites and forty-four 367-square-foot Penthouses. Crystal Symphony also features two

Crystal Penthouses which are approximately 982 square feet, and are among the largest, most elegantly appointed and comfortable penthouses afloat.

During the ship's refurbishment in 2009, the Penthouses (category PH), Penthouse Suites (category PS) and Crystal Penthouses all received new furnishings. The Crystal Penthouses were completely renovated and now feature an oversized bathroom, elegant dining area and a powder room with an all-crystal pedestal sink. Penthouse Suites and Penthouses have new headboards, carpeting and curtains in a color palette of creams and neutrals. We redesigned the cabinetry in the Penthouses and installed flat-screen televisions. And, of course, all penthouses and staterooms have CD and DVD capabilities.

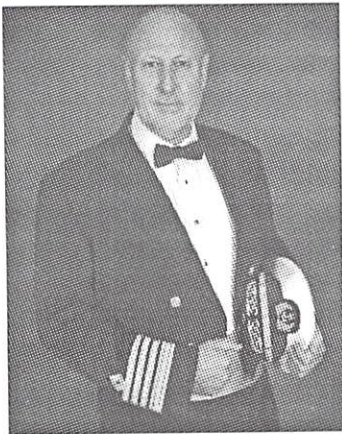
It isn't every day that we dress up so elegantly—that is part of what makes this evening so special. Make the memory of this spectacular

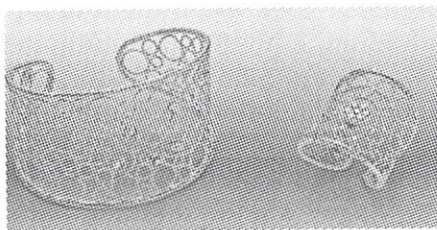
be ready to navigate Crystal Symphony on some of her more adventurous routes, from the Arctic Circle to Antarctica itself.

Extra Caution During Rough Seas

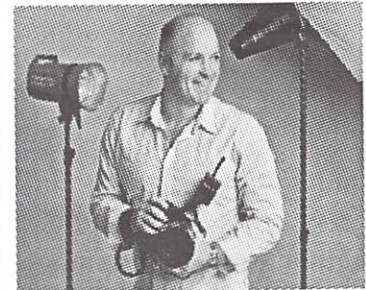
Crystal Cruises has our guests' safety in mind at all times. We would like to make our guests aware that we may anticipate bad weather at times and possible rough seas at short notice.

Master photographer David MacDonald



David MacDonald is a Fellow of both the British Institute of Professional Photography (BIPP) and the Master Photographers Association (MPA). He has received numerous honors including, the Kodak United Kingdom Portrait Photographer of the Year, the MPA UK Family Portrait Photographer of the Year and the MPA UK (under 5 year olds Portrait Photographer of the Year. In addition, he serves as a judge for professional qualification reviews for both British photographic associations and lectures to photographers around the world.



PERSONALITY PROFILE

Classical Pianist Rustem Hayroudinoff

Described by London's Classic FM magazine as a "sensationally gifted" musician of "stunning artistry," Rustem Hayroudinoff graduated from the Moscow Conservatory and received his postgraduate degree at the Royal Academy of Music in London.



His performances have been broadcast on most of the world's major classical radio stations. Rustem has recorded for NAMI Records (Japan), Decca and Chandos. His recordings of Shostakovich's Theatre Music and the Dvorak Piano Concerto with the BBC Philharmonic were greeted with universal acclaim, garnering praise such as "dazzling and... electrically compelling" (Gramophone) and "utterly magical" (Classic FM). His CD of the Rachmaninoff Complete Preludes was selected by Classic FM magazine as a part of the 'four discs essential Rachmaninoff collection', alongside the recordings by Arthur Rubinstein and Andre Previn, and the latest recording of the Complete Etudes-Tableaux by Rachmaninoff became the Instrumental Choice of the Month with the BBC Music magazine.

Rustem has performed to great critical acclaim in Japan, United States, his native Russia and Europe. In the UK he appeared in major concert venues including St John's Smith Square, the Barbican, the Queen Elizabeth Hall and the Wigmore Hall. His recital in Chicago was televised and simultaneously broadcast live by over 300 radio stations across the United States. In 2010 he made a recital debut in New York, of which Vanity Fair wrote: "The only question that remained after the recital was, Why isn't Hayroudinoff better known and playing a larger venue, such as the big stage at Carnegie Hall?"

Amongst the orchestras Hayroudinoff has performed with are the Sofia Symphony, the Osaka Century Orchestra, the Tokyo Symphony, the BBC Philharmonic, the Bournemouth Symphony, the Czech Philharmonic and the London Philharmonic. After his debut with the latter in Rachmaninoff's Third Piano Concerto The Independent wrote: "The piano soloist was a sensationally gifted pianist from Russia, Rustem Hayroudinoff. What a performance this was, demonstrating the emotional range of this wonderful work, full of mercurial brilliance, impassioned melody and breathtaking virtuosity." He also appeared in the documentary "The Unknown Shostakovich" alongside Vladimir Ashkenazy, Valery Gergiev and Maxim Shostakovich.

His recording of the Rachmaninoff Etudes-Tableaux was nominated for the BBC Music magazine Best Instrumental CD of the Year Award. It was also selected as the finest available version on BBC Radio 3's Building a Library.

Each evening on a Crystal cruise has a specific dress code for dining areas that also applies to all public areas of the ship after 6:00pm (except for alfresco dining on deck when available). If you choose to change your attire following the evening dinner and other festivities, please maintain a minimum of style of dress in keeping with the dress code for Casual Evening Attire (described in detail below). Guests find that the occasional formal nights create a special atmosphere in contrast to the other more informal or casual nights on board. The three codes of attire are formal, informal and casual. Typically, 10- to 14-day cruises have three formal nights. The number of informal nights is usually based on the number of days at sea, and casual nights are based on days in port or the time of departure. For your convenience, your cruise ticket lists the number of specific dress code evenings during your stay on board.

Formal Evening Attire.

Formal attire is evening dresses and gowns of fashionable length for ladies, and a tuxedo, dinner jacket or dark suit and tie for gentlemen. Jeans, shorts, casual slacks, sport shirts and caps or baseball hats are not permitted in the dining room or our specialty restaurants after 6:00pm.

Informal Evening Attire.

Informal attire is appropriate for most evenings on board. For ladies, this is evening cocktail dresses or pantsuits. Gentlemen wear suits or sport coats and slacks; ties are optional. Jeans, shorts, sport shirts and caps or baseball hats are not permitted in the dining room or our specialty restaurants after 6:00pm.

Casual Evening Attire.

On casual evenings, a more relaxed attire is accepted, such as casual dresses and pantsuits for ladies, and sport shirts and slacks for gentlemen. Ties and jackets are not required. Shorts and baseball caps are not permitted after 6:00pm. Casual daytime attire is not considered acceptable attire after 6:00pm.

In particular, smoking is prohibited on stateroom and penthouse verandahs. Lit cigarettes or cigars left unattended or thrown over the side could potentially cause a serious fire hazard if the wind would blow the cigarette/cigar or embers back on board.

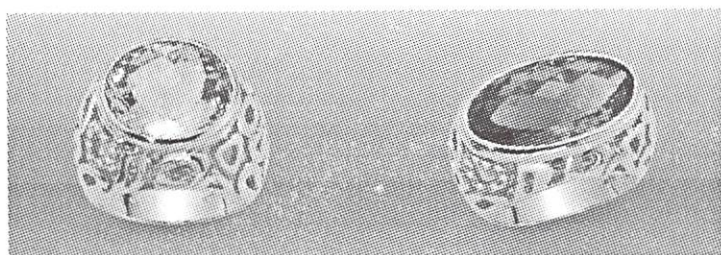

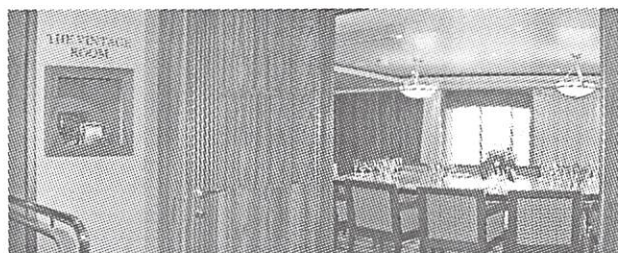
