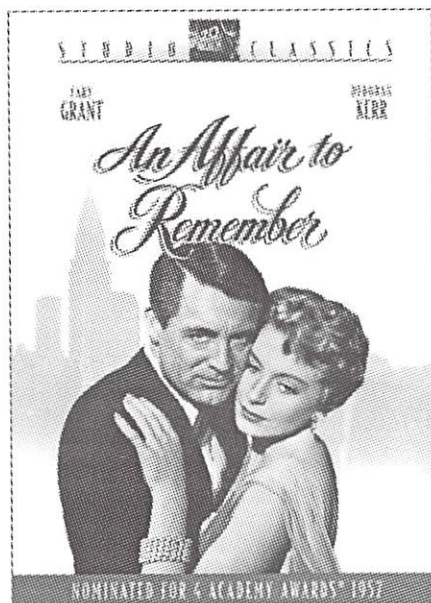
But if it's glamour and fun we're after, then movies about cruise ships are just the ticket. It's an opulent environment of sophisticated people, visiting exotic ports or enjoying leisurely days at sea.

Fascinating personalities just may walk out of that stateroom, or the next port could be a gateway to romance. Possibilities are endless for cinematic exploration.

For many, the first movie that comes to mind in the cruise ship genre is *An Affair to Remember*. But Cary Grant and Deborah Kerr would never have met on that luxurious ship if it weren't for Charles Boyer and Irene Dunne meeting first in *Love Affair*. This excellent 1939 comedy-drama is witty at first, then subdued and dramatic.

Like all good movies, we feel drawn into the lives of the performers, developing a rooting interest and emotional investment in what happens to them. That is one of the reasons many newer films don't connect with us in the same way, and that is why the 1994 remake of *Love Affair* failed. Warren Beatty and Annette Bening were photogenic, but the heart and soul were buried under the glossy, expensive production. Climb aboard the original *Love Affair* and 1957's unforgettable *An Affair to Remember*.

in one of the best musicals Hollywood ever made: *Gentlemen Prefer Blondes*.

This 1953 satire tells the tale of two show business girls from Little Rock determined to make it big in Paris. But getting there is all the fun as Jane Russell tries to control the gold-digging style of Marilyn Monroe. Both actresses have never been better, and the musical numbers sparkle. Marilyn getting stuck in a porthole, Jane taking over the ship's gym with a team of musclemen, the iconic fifties clothes... *Gentlemen Prefer Blondes* is a cruise worth taking.

There are lesser-known movies set on cruise ships. Federico Fellini's 1983 *And the Ship Sails On* introduced us to a group of devoted opera lovers taking a cruise to pay their respects to a recently deceased opera diva. In 1998, *The Imposters* gave us wacky comedy about third-rate actors hiding out on a ship, slinking around in an array of disguises and costumes. Doris Day became a star with *Romance on the High Seas*. This 1948 comedy costarred Doris singing "It's Magic," and told the rest of the world what big band music lovers had known for quite a while: Doris Day was very special indeed.

Music also plays a role in an underrated 2002 movie *The Cat's Meow*. Based on one of the infamous Hollywood scandals of the 1920s, we meet a group of famous folks on William Randolph Hearst's yacht. We meet Marion Davies, Charlie Chaplin, Louella Parsons and Hearst himself as mystery soon takes the place of drinking and dancing. Things get messy, but that classic yacht is perfection! *Out to Sea* in 1997 gave us a fictional cruise with Walter Matthau and Jack Lemmon pretending to be dance

hosts. At least there are a few moments with the great dancer Donald O'Connor that keeps us singin' in the rain!

From *A Night to Remember* to *Titanic* to *The Last Voyage* and *The Poseidon Adventure*, cruise ships are often used to recreate or imagine drama. While those movies are popular, for many of us in love with the joy and glamour of a fabulous cruise ship, it will always be *An Affair to Remember*.

Tribute to W. A. Mozart

The world of music has been blessed with many outstanding creative geniuses. Arguably the most notable of these is Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756 – 1791).

A child prodigy of the first order, Mozart was thoroughly trained by his father, Leopold, who was also a noted musician and pedagogue from Salzburg, Austria, where Wolfgang was born.

Mozart's creativity was given the opportunity to flourish as a youth while he was paraded through every musical center in Europe during extensive touring. In fact, by the time Mozart was 15 years old, he had been "on the road" for over half of his life. He absorbed every style with uncanny aptitude, and his works became a synthesis of all the current national styles. In this assimilation process, he also personalized and improved each style. By the time he had completed his tours, he was recognized throughout Europe as a leading virtuoso performer and composer.



From his first symphony at age eight and his first opera at ten, he produced over 600 works in his short 35 years. In every musical form, from symphony to opera, concerto to sonata, oratorio to string quartet, his music at once laid the foundation for Beethoven and the whole of 19th Century Romanticism, and he created the huge body of masterworks which we continue to enjoy today. As stated by one of Mozart's patrons in the film *Amadeus*, surely there is a "touch of the miraculous, something both child-like and God-like, about all this. . . ." There is, after all, only one Mozart.

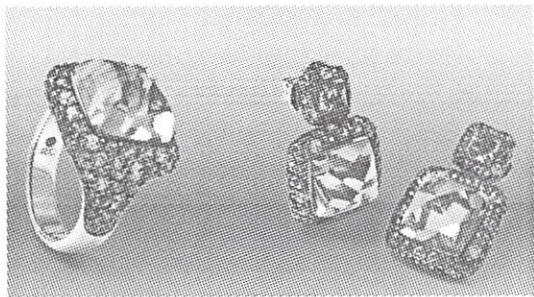

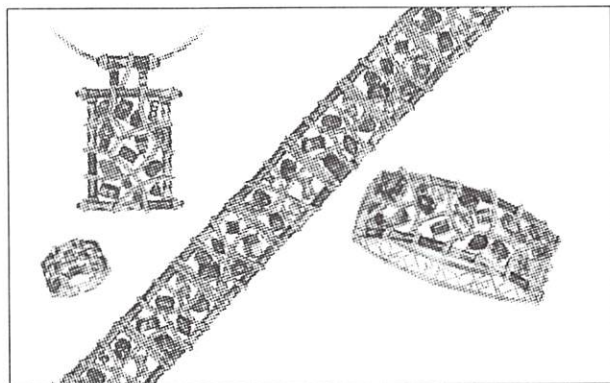

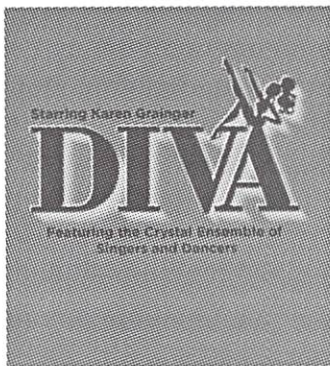
